

Education Issues Report

- 1. The Welsh Government's consultation on 'Securing Access to the full curriculum'.** The closing date is 28th of November 2019. See my response in the enclosed report. It is important that denominational members who are members of local authority SACREs or who have expertise in educational matters respond to and are vigilant regarding these developments.
- 2. Brexit and Schools.** This 5 page document 'Guidance – EU exit: no deal preparations for schools in Wales' which was published on 5th of April 2019 (see the enclosed document) focuses on: Settled status applications for EU/EEA and Swiss nationals; School Places; Preparations as an employer, including the recognition of teaching qualifications for EEA and Swiss nationals; Checking for EEA regulating authority teacher sanctions or restrictions; Travel to the EU; Data Protection; Food supplies and Erasmus+.
- 3. The contributions of individuals and agencies to teaching Curriculum for Wales 2022,** e.g. Opening the Book (RE), Brook's possible input in preparing a wide range of RSE programmes in both primary and secondary schools. See also the Rev. Aled Davies' list (currently 23) of groups and individuals who could contribute to the delivery of the new curriculum.
- 4. Free Church Council for Wales.** I was present at a meeting of the FCEC in London on 30th of October. I presented a report and updated members on the latest developments in Wales.
